Landfill Property & HCRCM Flying Field Guidelines (Effective June 8th, 2018)

Beginning in 2018, HCRCM has to sign an annual land lease agreement with Hardin County and pay an annual fee of \$100.00 for our flying field. The Club signed our first land lease agreement in early May of 2018.

The lease contains a clause requiring us to call the county's non-Emergency phone number and let them know when we are on the property as well as when we leave. The *first person in* must call to inform the County that we are on the premises, the *last person out* must call to report that we have left. It does not matter *who* makes either call, just as long as *someone* makes the appropriate call. *Please work with your fellow club members by sharing in this responsibility when multiple members are arriving or leaving.*

When arriving to the property, the j	<i>first-one-in</i> is to call 270-737-5669 and
state the following: My name is	with the flying club calling to let
you know we are on the old Landfill p	property off Springfield Road.
When leaving the property, the last-	<i>-one-out</i> is to call 270-737-5669 and state
the following: My name is	with the flying club calling to let you
know we have left the old Landfill pro	operty off Springfield Road.

Regardless of the responses on the part of the operators, please adapt accordingly. The bottom line is simple - we are required to make both of these phone calls per the land lease agreement so the County has a record of authorized people on and off the property.

Miscellaneous notes

- 1. If you forget to call and say you have left the property, just do so at your first opportunity after leaving.
- 2. If you do not carry a cell phone, you will need to make the first call sometime before arriving to the field, and the 2nd call (I have left the property) at your first opportunity after leaving.

Flying Guidelines

- 1. Most importantly, fly safely according to <u>AMA Safety</u> <u>Guidelines</u>. Equally important, have fun.
- 2. Announce your intentions in a clear, loud voice. If you are landing announce **landing**. If you are taking off announce **taking off**.
- 3. Never enter the runway without first looking both ways for aircraft. Announce very clearly your intention to enter the runway by saying loudly **on the runway**. After leaving the runway say loudly **runway clear**.
- 4. Aircraft in distress have the right of way. Please accommodate dead stick landings as much as possible.
- 5. Takeoffs and landings are to be done into the wind as much as practicable. Low altitude passes should be done in the same direction as takeoffs and landings.
- 6. **No** flying west of the fence or over the shelter. **No** taxiing past the fence.
- 7. Please do not leave garbage at the field. If you bring drinks or food or whatever, take everything back. If you find someone else's garbage, be kind and pick it up too.
